SCRATCHES: Refunds will be made for sickness, injury, death or bitches in season.
Notice must be given to the event secretary prior to the start of the test and a
veterinarian's letter on letterhead must be sent to WRGRC within one
week of the test date. **Bitches in season are not allowed on the test grounds.**

Purpose and Certification

The WC and WCX are designed to test the working ability of Golden and Flat-Coated Retrievers and will be conducted in accordance with the AKC Field Trial rules as modified by the GRCA and FCRSA. Golden retrievers will be run under the rules set forth by the GRCA while Flat-Coats will be run under the rules set forth by the FCRSA. All retriever breeds, Irish Water Spaniels and Standard Poodles are welcome to enter. However, only Golden and Flat-Coated Retrievers will qualify for certification under these rules. Golden and Flat-Coated Retrievers meeting the test requirements will automatically have their pass recorded with their respective national organization and will subsequently receive a title certificate from either GRCA or FCRSA.

All dogs entered will receive a duck band. All dogs, regardless of breed, that qualify under the rules will receive a card of congratulations from GRCA and a WRGRC memento.

WC/WCX Test Regulations

Copies of the complete WC/WCX requirements will be at the test headquarters and are also available online at: www.grca.org/wcwcx.htm Gun handling is not required and white clothing may be worn by the dog handler. **BRING BOOTS SINCE IT MAY BE NECESSARY TO WALK ACROSS A SHALLOW CREEK.** Arrive on time in order to hear the judges' instructions to the handlers. Dogs will be run in catalog order, unless otherwise requested by the judges.

Test Site

Crooked Creek Conservation and Gun Club, 13203 E. 246th St., Noblesville, IN 46060

From I-69 going North from I-465: Take the IN-37 N/116th Street Exit 5. Stay to the left and merge onto IN-37. Continue north on IN-37 past Noblesville (approx. 13.5 miles) and turn left onto IN-213. Proceed north on IN-213 1.2 miles and turn right (east) on 246th Street and continue .6 miles to Crooked Creek Gun Club on the right (south).

From the east or west: Take I-70 or I-74 to I-465 and go to I-69 on the northeast side of Indianapolis, then follow directions above

From I-69 going South: Take I-69 south to SR 28. Go west on SR 28 to SR 213 and go south to 246th Street. Turn east (left) and continue .6 miles to Crooked Creek Gun Club on the right (south).

From the North: Take US 31 south to SR 28 and go east on SR 28 to SR 213. Go south (right) on SR 213 to 246th Street. Turn east (left) and continue .6 miles to Crooked Creek Gun Club on the right (south)
